Roosevelt Academy of Leadership & Applied Technology is now open to application by any student (ESE or Non-ESE) in Grade 6 to 12 for the 2018/2019 school year.

Application Process

1. Parent/Guardian completes the student application. The application is located on the Roosevelt website and in the school office.
2. Completed application is delivered to the main office in several ways: By mail or in person or by email to michelle.gifford@polk-fl.net.
3. If student has an IEP or 504 please provide a copy with application.
4. The team of Roosevelt Guidance and Administration will review each application for the student's IEP (if ESE), Attendance, and Discipline Record. The current school may be contacted if there are any questions or concerns.
5. An informational meeting is scheduled for the parents/guardians of students who are candidates for acceptance.
6. If an applicant does not become a candidate, guidance notifies the parent/guardian to let them know why.
7. An individual interview may be necessary if the application review team needs further information.
8. Parents/Guardians are notified of acceptance or non-acceptance by letter.

Examples of Ineligibility include:

1. Student has had a serious breach of conduct within the current or previous (if in the summer) semester
2. Student has been involved in more than one physical/violent type of behavior, to include fighting, self-injury, throwing objects, or any other intentional behavior to harm self or others.
